

Cedar Creek™

Landscape Border



Starter Set:

Dimensions: Posts are about 24" long, rails 48". Installed, posts are 16" tall and top rails sit 14" above ground. **Directions:** First, call your local "Dig Line" to have all buried lines marked. **How to Install:** The combination post serves as either a starter post or corner post, so if you have a corner in your border, start the fence at the corner. Avoiding buried lines, dig a hole 8" deep. Put the combination post in the hole and backfill, tamping the dirt firmly. Dig the next hole 4' from the center of the first post. Insert the rails in the installed post, then set the other post in its hole, lean it into the rails, and tamp it firmly into place. In the same manner, add as many Extension Sets as needed. **Note:** If any continuous run has more than one corner, substitute a Starter Set in place of an Extension Set for each *extra* corner in that run.



Extension Set:

Dimensions: Posts are about 24" long, rails 48". Installed, posts are 16" tall and top rails sit 14" above ground. **Directions:** First, call your local "Dig Line" to have all buried lines marked. **How to Install:** Measure 4' from the center of the already installed post and, avoiding all buried lines, dig a hole 8" deep. Insert the rails in the already installed post. Set the next post in its hole, lean it into the rails and tamp it firmly into place. In the same manner, add as many Extension Sets as needed to complete your border. **Note:** If any continuous run has more than one corner, substitute a Starter Set in place of an Extension Set for each *extra* corner in that run.
